# 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter 2009 revenues: + 10.4%

#### **Achievements**

In a market that was down over the guarter, NEURONES' 3<sup>rd</sup> guarter revenues (€50.2 million) increased by + 10.4% (including + 1.7% organic growth).

Business operating profit\* was 9.9% in the 3rd quarter and totalled around 9% of revenues over the first three quarters of the year (for an operating profit of 8.4%).

### Outlook

For 2009, NEURONES maintains its forecast of over €210 million in revenues and has adjusted its operating profit prediction to around 8.5% (up from a forecast of 7.5-8.5%).
